Tuscan Red Wine I.G.T. 2015

“Poggio Galardi in Anfora”

Type	Organic Wine
Denomination	IGT – Rosso di Toscana
Production area	Tuscany, Florentine hills (Fiesole)
Alcohol level	14,5 %
Variety	Merlot (55%), Cabernet (45%)
Soil type	Lean soil, Galestro, limestone
Training System	Low-spurred cordon and Guyot, Organic farming
Harvest time	End of August (Merlot) – Mid September (Cabernet Sauvignon)
Winemaking	Soft destemming, crushing and pressing; fermentation by selected yeast with temperature control in stainless-steel vats with pumping over and délestages.
Ageing	First in stainless-steel vats; then in medium toasted oak barrels and terracotta amphora; finally, in the bottle. The wine is bottled avoiding strict filtration methods, which do impart translucency and clarity to a wine, but inevitably also destabilize its structure. During the ageing in bottle, any sediment, due to the crystallization of potassium salts - naturally occurred in grapes - should be considered the result of a normal evolution of a wine with a powerful structure and with a high concentration, intensified by the ageing in terracotta
Colour	Intense ruby red, with garnet reflexes after ageing
Aroma	The three ageing phases determine notable aromatic fullness. Distinct sensations then blend harmoniously for a perfect balance of aroma and taste.
Taste	Wide, well-marked on the nose with clear notes of primary aromas; ripe red fruit taste and a remarkable structure.
Pairing	Its characteristics unfold best with red meat, game and stewed meats. When aged, it can be considered a pleasant meditation wine.
Serving	18-20°C. We recommend opening the bottle and decanting the wine prior to serving in wide crystal glass.
Best consumption	Within 8 years from harvest.
